







 - "Ground zero" of colonial impact
 - Contains examples applicable across Parks system





- Not Case Studies, but stories
 - We're centering narrative
 - Identified 27 stories that illustrate the current effects of colonialism

- 21 interviews over 5 months
 - Across 7 departments
 - 106 pages of notes





Reflections on Process



- Resistance
- Trepidation
- Lack of capacity to support





- People have rants/things they want to get off their chests
 - E.g. roadblocks, inefficiencies, inherited decisions, inequities in the system





 Valuable questions included: "At the end of the day, what are you setting out to accomplish in your role?"

















- Role of Reconciliation team



Next Steps – Internal Facing



- Cross-departmental data keeping
 - So much baseline data to gather and collect starting today
 - The audit identified more than 70 data points across many departments
