

Stanley Park Drive Temporary Bike Lane Removal - Phase 2

WHEREAS:

- On December 5, 2022, the Board passed a motion titled "<u>Stanley Park Drive</u> <u>Temporary Bike Lane – Next Steps</u>", which directed staff to immediately restore the pre-COVID-19 traffic and parking configuration on Stanley Park Drive, amongst other things; and
- 2. The Board received a <u>memo on December 15, 2022</u> identifying areas requiring further study due to the complexities of the road network prior to implementation of Part A of the December 5, 2022 motion.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- A. THAT the Board directs staff to consider recommendations for site specific modifications that could be repurposed from the current configuration that would improve safety, accessibility, traffic flow, way-finding, and aesthetics on Stanley Park Drive, over the pre-COVID-19 configuration without unduly delaying the removal works or materially increasing costs, in the implementation planning of Part A of the December 5, 2022 motion;
- B. THAT staff specifically consider modifications in areas including, but not limited to, the Tea House access, Brockton Point, the road leading up to Prospect Point, and Ceperley Meadows; and
- C. THAT staff report back to the Board no later than February 13, 2023, with recommendations related to Items A and B above.
