| 16-Jan-23 | Commissioner Digby | <p>Commissioners request a summary of the Park Board’s current park planning policy framework for coastal and intertidal adaption in view of anticipated sea level rise and loss of coastal biodiversity between now and 2050.</p> <p>Please include any corresponding policies and plans of the City (e.g Vancouver Plan 2050, Vancouver’s Changing Shoreline 2018) which impact parks on these topics.</p> <p>For context, issues of particular interest to Commissioners include policies governing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The repairs required by the 2022 King Tide storm (including the Jericho Pier, Kits Beach - East walking path, Kits pool, etc.), The increased flooding potential along the Fraser River, Sea-level considerations for siting the new Vancouver Aquatic Centre and the developing English Bay plan, Opportunities for enhanced coastal and intertidal biodiversity including salt marshes and daylighting of streams, and The possible futures of the Stanley Park Seawall in view of sea-level rise. | Staff are preparing a response |
