# CRAB Park Encampment Clean-up

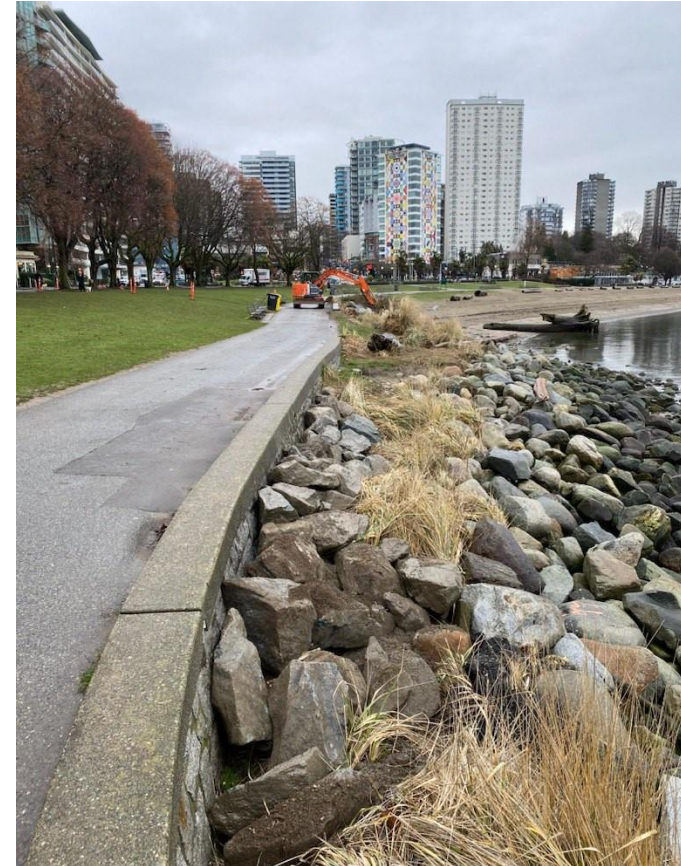
- On February 7 staff across many departments performed another debris and garbage clean up of CRAB Park
