STAFF REPORTS / PRESENTATIONS

Sports Field Renovations

The Board revived an update on preparations and work planned for the <u>sports fields and ball diamonds in 2023</u>. Sports fields in Vancouver are very heavily used, in 2022, during the Spring and Summer season, there were over 15K bookings, and in Fall and Winter 3937 bookings. The purpose of Sports Field maintenance is to immediately improve citywide playing conditions as well as address the public safety concerns our current fields present. Staff have begun a year-round field maintenance program to improve field quality and consistency of the Citywide Sports Field network.
