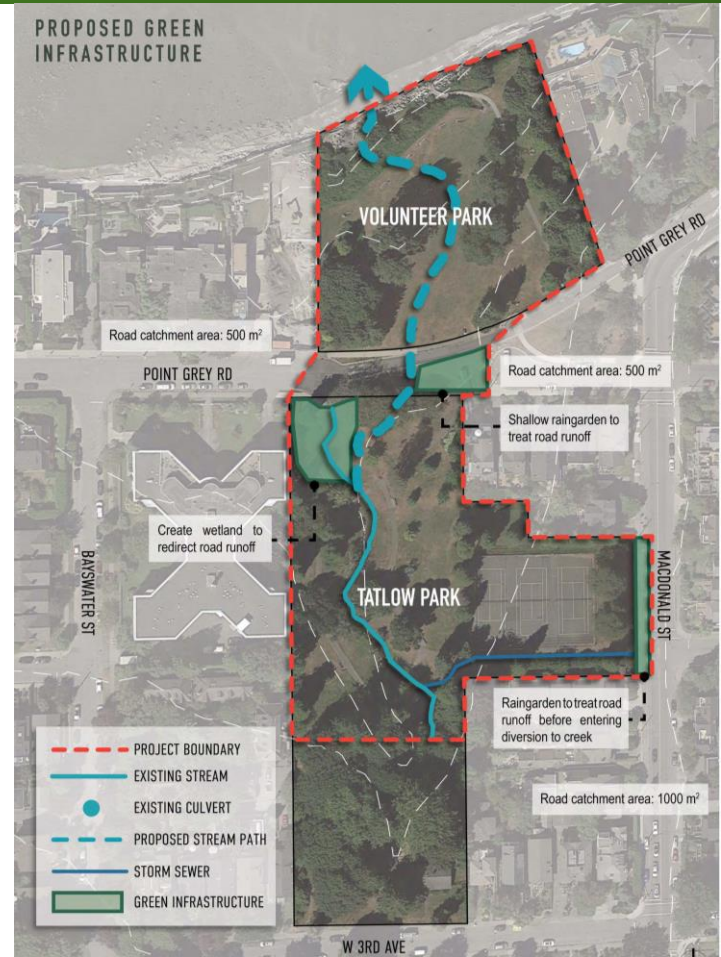
Stanley Park seawall (between Lions Gate Bridge & Second Beach) remains closed due to safety issues related to this week's cold weather.

# Tatlow and Volunteer Parks Creek Daylighting

- Construction is on schedule to begin in March for the Tatlow and Volunteer Parks Creek Daylighting project
- Staff have been working on the design since 2016
- Opportunity to collaborate with the Host First Nations, restore the creek, improve water quality, enhance biodiversity, and improve the health and access to the foreshore
- Construction completion is targeted for Q4-2023





# Vancouver Meadows Award

- The 'Vancouver Meadows' project was awarded Certificate of Merit by the International Association of Horticultural's World Green City Awards, 2022
- The project has to date transitioned 42 hectares of lawns into valuable pollinator meadow habitat
