Oppenheimer Park Playground Renewal

- Playground renewal will provide an enhanced play space for children and caregivers creating a playground that is safe, inclusive and fun
- New features include climbing play structures, seesaw, basket swing, picnic area, and rubber surfacing
- Recipient of a \$30k Tire Stewardship BC grant to provide partial funding for poured in place recycled rubber play surfacing
- Construction targeted for Spring 2024



- In June 2023, Vancouver Tennis Society (VTS) partnered with Park Board to run sport participation events, funded through a ParticiPACTION grant.
- Free events removed financial carriers to introduce Tennis to newcomers, people with limited mobility, Indigenous communities, and the general public.
- 4 events, 8 total sessions, 155 participants

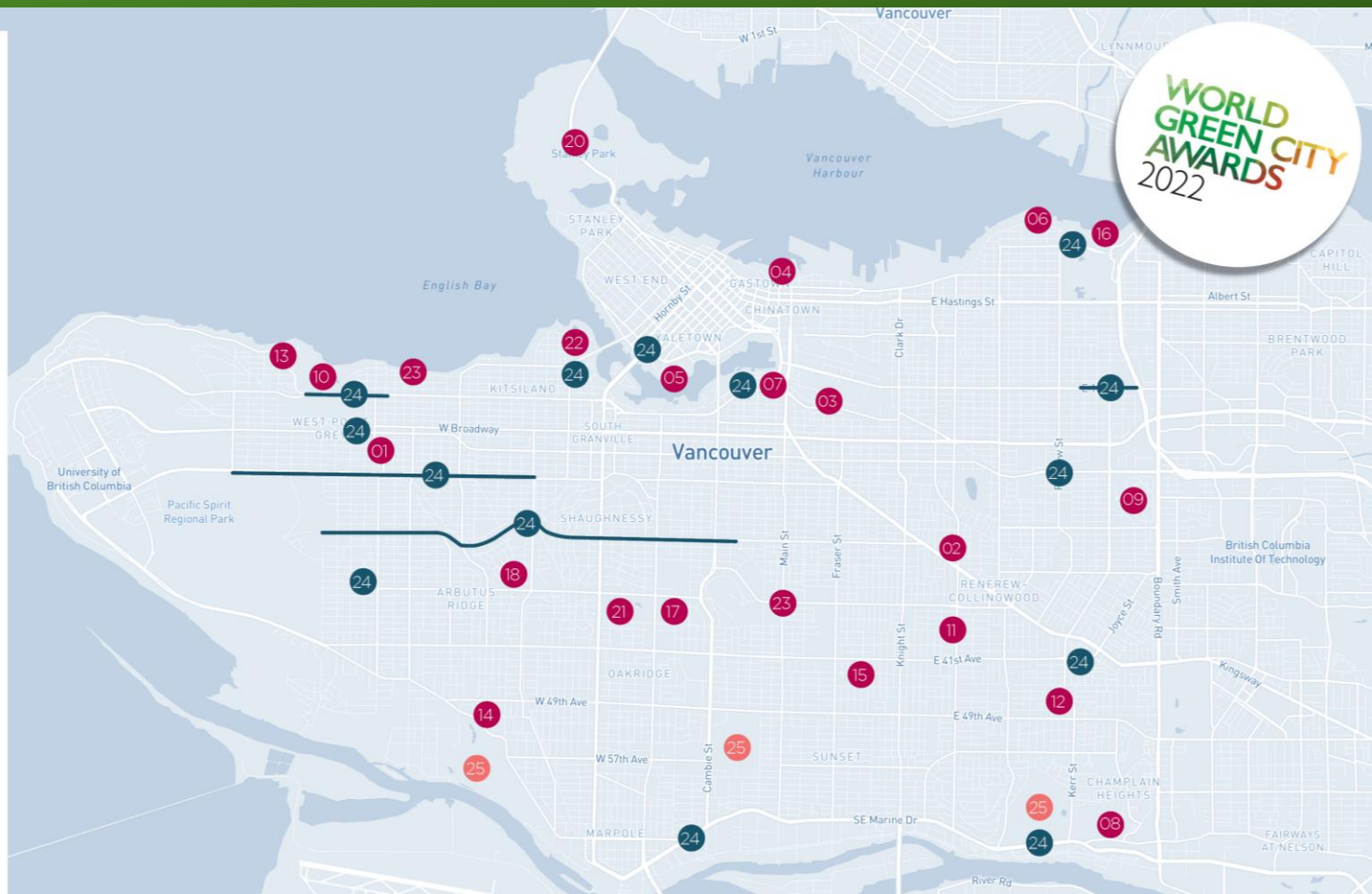
