Regular Park Board Meeting
Monday, May 27, 2024



- Youth Week in BC was celebrated from May 1 – 7 2024.
- Involved 3 city-wide events including:
 - Queer Prom for 2SLGBTQIA+ youth
 - Youth Week Skate Jam at Plaza Skate Park
 - Indoor volleyball tournament at Killarney
- Smaller community events were held at Community Centers across the city, including a carnival, video game themed sports day, volunteer appreciation BBQ, and a basketball tournament.




- Irrigation main replacement completed in May 2024.
- Approx. 800 meters of 100mm diameter PVC irrigation line has been installed.
- Irrigation water supply fully restored to:
 - Rose Garden
 - Lawn Bowling
 - Small Quarry
 - Large Quarry
- Queen Elizabeth Park welcomes 6 million visitors per year, this repair ensures continued high level of service.



Musqueam Park Trail Bridge Replacement

- Contractor has been selected through public tender process for replacement of the pedestrian bridge across Musqueam Creek.
- x^wməθk^wəy'əm (Musqueam) Archaeology Department will be providing cultural monitoring.
- Construction will begin August 2024, with anticipated completion October 2024.

Council Items related to Parks & Recreation



- Council to receive a report on May 28, 2024, titled “[Arbutus Greenway – Establishment of City Land for Street and Public Space Purposes](#)”, which would approve establishing the Arbutus Greenway for street and public use, solidifying the use of the greenway as a transportation corridor and creating better integration with parks and public space.
- Council to receive another report on May 28, 2024, titled “[New Agreements for the following Childcare Centres: 3 Corners Childcare Centre, International Village Children’s Centre and Learning Tree Daycare](#)”, which would authorize City staff to execute a new lease with three licensed non-profit group childcare operators, including a new lease for Mount Pleasant CCA to operate 3 Corners Childcare Centre.
- Council to receive a report for information on May 29, 2024, titled “[2025-2029 Budget Outlook](#)”, which outlines the City’s projected Operating and Capital financial outlook based on current state service levels.
- Council to receive a report on May 29, 2024, titled “[2024 Cultural Grants \(CASC, Capacity, Cultural Spaces\)](#)”, which would approve several cultural grants for projects and events around the City.
