Mobile Building Workers



- Expanded Mobile Building
 Workers Team to provide more
 consistent service delivery to
 60+ locations, 100+
 washrooms and changerooms
- Two shifts operational 7 days a week, 365 days a year
- Completed deep cleaning of all beach locations and developed schedules to ensure comprehensive site maintenance



Spanish Banks Water Main Replacement



- Water main replacement completed Water supply has been fully restored to
 the west concession building,
 washroom facilities, lifeguard station
 and fire hydrant
- New water supply services have been provided for special events in the park and dust suppression at the volleyball courts
- Non-invasive construction methodology selected to ensure protection of a nearby culturally significant area, and archaeological monitoring was conducted throughout the work








Broadway Public Realm – Phase 2 Engagement



- Phase 2 of public engagement for the Broadway Public Realm to begin on June 13.
- Work is being led by COV Planning Department in collaboration with Parks Planning and other COV departments
- Engagement identified park and public space inventory and prioritization of new spaces through redevelopment and land acquisition
- The Plan's expected completion date is the end of 2024.



New Public Space in Broadway Plan Area



- On May 30, Council approved rezoning for 130 W Broadway, the former site of Mountain Equipment Co-op store.
- Development will include a new 14,000 sqft. Privately Owned Public Space (POPs), above a new commercial podium and next to a new childcare facility
- Space will be accessible to the public through stairs and elevator, and a short ramp



2024 City Service Awards



- Park Rangers received the People's Choice Award.
 - Rangers are in the field 7 days a week, 18 hours a day, making Vancouver's parks and beaches safe, clean, and accessible.
- Jericho Lands team received the JEDI Award, recognizing their contribution to advancing Justice, Equity, Decolonization and Inclusion.
 - The Jericho Lands team was celebrated for its work on the <u>Jericho Lands Plan</u>, a complete community plan which will deliver approximately 20 acres of park space, 10 acres of public open space

- Council to receive a report on June 12, 2024, titled "Vancouver Official Development Plan Project Scope and Terms of Reference", which outlines the project scope to create Vancouver's first comprehensive city-wide Official Development Plan By-law, a new Provincial requirement, and key action to implement the Vancouver Plan.
- Council to receive a report on June 12, 2024, titled "<u>Establishing a Chinatown Cultural District</u>", which would approve the draft Chinatown Cultural District Framework to support the renewed vibrancy of the neighbourhood.
