



GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Regular Park Board Meeting
Monday, April 14, 2025





- The project will deliver a playground renewal and splash park improvements including: New swings, large play structure, bouncy riders, universal carousel, benches, tables with seating, and new trees.
- Upgrades to the spray pad include repainting of the existing water poles and paved surfacing.
- Construction start target – Q2 2025. Completion target – Q3 2025.

Council Items related to Parks & Recreation



- Council to receive a report on April 15, 2025, titled “[Vancouver Community Sport Event Grants – Spring 2025 Intake](#)”, which would approve 17 grants totaling \$78,600 in financial support for sporting events.
- Council to receive a report on April 15, 2025, titled “[2025 Cultural Grants](#)”, which would approve five Cultural Operating Funding – Institutions (COFI) grants totaling \$2.8M, and 38 Cultural Operating Funding – Annual (COFA) grants totaling \$927,000, funded from the 2025 Cultural Grants Operating Budget.
- Council to receive a report on April 15, 2025, titled “[Mobile Pump-out Service Provision and Aquatic Environments Action Plan Progress Update](#)”, which would approve a mobile sewage pump-out service being delivered in False Creek for the 2025 to 2027 boating season, and that any future service beyond 2027 be considered as Phase 3 of the Healthy Waters Plan.
- Council to receive a report on April 15, 2025, titled “[2025 Local By-election Results](#)”, in which the Chief Election Officer will declare the candidates, Sean Orr and Lucy Maloney, as elected.
- Council to receive a report on April 15, 2025, titled “[Jericho Lands Official Development Plan](#)”, which would adopt the Jericho Lands Official Development Plan, to regulate future rezoning applications and development of the Jericho Lands.
- Council to receive a report on April 16, 2025, titled “[Annual Procurement Report 2024](#)”, which documents the procurement activities of the City of Vancouver from January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024.
- Council to receive a report on April 16, 2025, titled “[Effective Water Use in the City of Vancouver](#)”, which provides a response to the January 22, 2025, Council motion of the same name, and provides an update to the Water Demand Management Strategy.
