

#### Context and Background









- 2014 Trans\* and Gender Variant Working Group Report delivered to Park Board
  - 2014 first RPT staff positions created
- 2016 Gender identity and gender expression added to BC Human Rights Code
- 2016 City of Vancouver Supporting Trans\*
  Equality and an Inclusive Vancouver passed
- 2022 two RFT Recreation Programmer positions created in Queer Inclusion, Access Services

Recommendation	Action	
Expand options in washrooms and change rooms	2016 – washroom signage updated to include "Gender Diverse People Welcome"; universal washroom options in new developments	
Create and adapt recreation programming for inclusion	2022 – Queer Inclusion program team expansion	
Remove financial barriers to facilities and programs	Ongoing – LAP referrals for 2STGD people; more community organizations are 3rd party referring agencies	
Equip staff with tools to be more welcoming and supportive of 2STGD communities	Ongoing – departmental communications and promotional materials; staff training on gender diversity	
Safety planning for 2STGS	Ongoing – safety planning process for 2STGD
