RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Vancouver Park Board approve a request from the West End Business Improvement Association for temporary festive lighting installations in Morton and Alexandra Parks between December 7, 2015 and January 31, 2016.



BACKGROUND

- West End BIA (WEBIA) is collaborating with several partners to host the second annual Lumière event on December 11 and 12, 2015
- Key objective of Lumière 2015 is to animate and beautify areas in the West End for the enjoyment of Vancouver residents and visitors



BACKGROUND

- Illumination will utilize a variety of lighting technologies
- Lumière initiative aligns with directions/ recommendations in the West End Community Plan
- Lumière 2015 builds upon several successful initiatives executed over the past two years by the WEBIA and its partners



2015 PROPOSAL

- WEBIA is proposing two temporary festive lighting installations:
 - Morton Park Illuminated three-dimensional whale motif; located at corner of Beach Avenue and Morton Avenue
 - Alexandra Park Illumination of the Haywood Bandstand with decorative umbrellas
- Display period would be from December 7, 2015 to January 31, 2016






Rendering of Morton Park Installation






Rendering of Morton Park Installation
