SUBJECT : Recreation Services Violence Risk Assessment Project

Dear Commissioners,

In an ongoing effort to ensure we deliver recreation services in a safe environment, a consultant was hired to conduct violence risk assessments in Community Centres from December 2016 to March 2017. In response to a recent Board enquiry seeking a status update on this initiative, following is a project overview.

Project Objectives

- Identify gaps within the Recreation Services Violence Prevention Program
- Meet requirements of WorkSafe BC's OHS Regulation 4.28 (Violence in the Workplace Risk Assessment)
- Improve employee safety in the area of workplace violence

Variables Considered

- Layout and design
- Neighbourhood
- Services provided
- Security infrastructure

- Facility partners
- Incident history
- Safety culture

Methodology -

Data and information gathered by consultant Glen Brown.

- Environmental walk-through
- Anonymous staff surveys
- Staff interviews

- Review of policies and procedures
- Comparison to other sites
- Review of previous incidents (12 months)

Results

Recreation work sites will focus on training, policies and procedures, and ongoing environmental evaluations and improvements to address issues including:

- Dealing with marginalized patrons
- Conflict between patrons

- Fee payment and facility access
- Enforcing rules
